



December is “Parade Month” in the North Valley



This Sunday, December 5th, The Granada Hills Chamber of Commerce’s Annual Granada Hills Holiday Parade starts at 1:30 pm on Chatsworth Street and runs from Petit to Zelzah Avenue. The theme of this year’s parade is “*Favorite Holiday Gifts and Presents,*” and will feature 150 entries and more than 4,000 youth participants. Marching bands, equestrian units, drill teams and decorated floats will delight onlookers.”

The Festival will be held at the Chatsworth Train Depot from 11:00 am to 5:00 pm. The Parade travels eastward on Devonshire Street from Jordan Avenue to Lurline Avenue starting at 1:00pm.
